EDUCATION/CERTIFICATIONS: Dr. Reuss and Dr. Schwartzberg are board certified in both orthopaedic surgery and sports medicine. Dr. Reuss graduated with honors from the University of Nebraska College of Medicine. He completed his orthopaedic surgery residency in Orlando and a sports medicine fellowship in Cincinnati. During his fellowship, he was associate team physician to the NFL's Cincinnati Bengals, the University of Cincinnati, and the ATP Professional Tennis Tour. Dr. Schwartzberg graduated from the University of Michigan and then the University of Florida College of Medicine. He performed his orthopaedic surgery residency in Orlando and his sports medicine fellowship in Birmingham, Ala. During his fellowship, he helped provide sports medicine care for Auburn University, NFL Europe and numerous other sports teams. **ACADEMIC AFFILIATIONS:** Both serve as clinical faculty for UCF's College of Medicine, and the sports medicine clinical faculty for Orlando Health's orthopaedic surgery residency program, where Dr. Schwartzberg is also director of sports medicine education. Both conduct research, publish literature and teach advanced surgical skills to orthopaedic surgeons.
