GIVE KIDS SPORTS

Our Give Kids Sports initiative helps children throughout Central Florida participate in youth sports programs they otherwise may not be able to afford. The effort also focuses on injury prevention education to help ensure youth athletes develop a lifetime of healthy habits playing the sports they love.



Family Fitness Fest is our free, annual community event aimed at improving strength and agility through different fitness activities. This year, proceeds from the event provided more than **100** summer sports camp scholarships.

Working with our community partners, we provided **20** new pairs of athletic shoes to the Young Overcomer's Club at the Kaley Square Community Center in Parramore. This local program enables young people to meet and interact with male role models, learn essential life skills, and have access to a safe place to play in Orlando.



We sent **125+** children to summer sports camps in 2017.

Through our Give Kids Sports initiative, we sponsored an 8-week afterschool sports program for **60+** children at the Boys and Girls Club of East Altamonte.

The Orlando Orthopaedic Center Foundation provides ongoing educational opportunities to those interacting with and supporting young athletes.

We host two annual seminars to provide physicians, physicians assistants, athletic trainers, and students the opportunity to learn evidence-based practices and the latest techniques and surgical procedures used to treat orthopaedic conditions.

EDUCATION



More than **1,500** attendees earned continuing education units (CEUs) while discovering the latest technology and best practices to treat orthopaedic injuries thanks to **715** volunteer hours dedicated to our two annual education seminars.

Launched in 2017, the Women's Wellness Luncheon was established for the education, empowerment, and pursuit of excellence in women's wellness. The inaugural event hosted more than **100** women.



INJURY PREVENTION

The Orlando Orthopaedic Center Foundation provides high school sports physicals to student-athletes at more than 20 area schools completely free of charge. Schools often charge a small fee for these physicals to offset budget shortfalls within their athletic departments.

This year, we provided more than **2,000** pre-participation sports physicals to local athletes. The efforts included **19** events, **2,036** students, **21** Orlando Orthopaedic Center employees and more than **350** volunteer hours donated by employees, students, and community members.
